

**School registrations are finalized only after tuition payments have been arranged.**

Dear Parent/Guardian:

The following is an explanation of the St. Paul School tuition policy:

The “**Non-Parish Rate**” of tuition is the actual annual cost per pupil. Non-parishioners may register at the “non-parish” tuition rate on a space available basis.

The “**Parish Rate**” of tuition is a subsidized rate of tuition for active and supporting members of St. Paul Church. The church then makes up the difference in cost per pupil.

The “Parish Rate” of tuition will be provided to families who are registered, active and supporting members at least one full year prior to registering their child/children. School families must use their offering envelopes since this is our only record of participation and financial support. The amount given is not the main issue, but the consistency of giving. An exception will be made for families that physically move into St. Paul Parish boundaries within the year prior to registration.

**PLEASE NOTE:** If you are a member of another Catholic church, you must make a request to your home parish for tuition subsidy from them. **St. Paul Church cannot subsidize families from other parishes.** For example, if you are a member of Little Flower Parish, you must apply for tuition subsidy from Little Flower no later than April 15 for the following school year. If you register your children at St. Paul School without obtaining proper authorization from your home parish, you will be responsible for paying the non-parish rate of tuition.
