The Values of Religion Based Learning

St. Paul Catholic School affords the fullest and best opportunity to realize the fourfold purpose of Christian education: to provide an atmosphere in which the Gospel message is proclaimed, community in Christ is experienced, service to our sisters and brothers is the norm, and thanksgiving and worship of God is cultivated.

In the primary grades, students learn about worship and cultivate prayer as a way to listen to and talk to God. They are immersed in rich faith lives through Gospel stories, prayer experiences and service.

Students in second grade prepare for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist through prayer and self-reflection. In grades three, four and five, students expand their knowledge of our faith history and tradition. They serve our community by visiting nursing homes, collecting donations for the parish food cupboard and creating gift bags for the local Samaritan's Table.

St. Paul Middle School students begin each Religion class in prayerful meditation with the rosary. They learn church history, read scripture and gain an understanding of Christ's teachings. They practice their faith in their daily lives. Eighth grade students prepare for their adult faith life through the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Individual Attention Produces Competitive Achievers

St. Paul provides a competitive learning opportunity for children from pre-school age through the eighth grade. As part of the Diocese of Youngstown, St. Paul School is a high-achieving school in which teachers and students interact closely. One-on-one attention is the norm rather than the exception. We administer the Iowa Test of Basic Skills yearly to benchmark student progress. Though not required by law, the State of Ohio off-grade, 8th grade proficiency is given to assure high student achievement. Children attending St. Paul School score the same or higher than the best neighboring school districts.
