Deadline

- ❖ The deadline for turning in completed forms and payment is **FRIDAY NOVEMBER 13, 2009. Ski Club will be LIMITED to the first 50 participants who turn in their completed forms and payment.** I must have your forms and payment by this date if you want to have your **three free passes*** by the Christmas break.
 - Please fill out ALL 3 forms (the School Club Release Form, the Medical Information Card, and the Field Trip Form) **COMPLETELY.** Please, **do not tear apart the two from the ski resort.** Return these to Carol Bonavita or Ski Club through the school office.

Schedule

- ❖ Before school, bring all your ski bags, equipment, and any other items you wish to bring on the trip to the Parish Life Center restrooms by the concession stand.
- ❖ 2:35 – released to Parish Life Center to change clothes in the locker rooms and restrooms and prepare for departure from school
- ❖ 2:40 – depart from St. Paul’s School (don’t leave anything!)
- ❖ 3:20 – arrive at Boston Mills Ski Resort—Peninsula, Ohio
- ❖ 3:30, 4:00, 4:30, 5:00, 5:30, and 6:00 – starting times for one hour lessons
- ❖ 7:00 – St. Paul’s is called off slopes
- ❖ 7:30 – bus departs for home, so don’t get in line for snacks late!
- ❖ 8:15 - 8:30 – parents pick up students at St. Paul’s

Identification – St. Paul’s Students and Advisors

Necktags are used to identify the person, his or her ability, and any lesson credits. (These tags are given to each person getting on the bus and are given back to an advisor on return to bus from the slopes)

- ❖ **Armbands** will be worn to identify St. Paul students on the slopes.
- ❖ ***Extra Pass Cards** – needed when going to Boston Mills/Brandywine on own time. **3 free passes to each student** which may be used any day except Wednesday, our ski day.

What to Bring on the Bus

- ❖ **Snack/Lunch/Dinner** – (a must -- especially the first trip – we really work up an appetite!) to eat on the way up. More food can be purchased at the resort later.
- ❖ **Bottled Beverage** – **must have screw top or some other secure closure. NO CANS!** Preferably you should bring water to drink (water is very important to keep from getting dehydrated in the cold weather)
- ❖ **Clothing** – long underwear, warm and waterproof ski gloves, ski socks (wool), hat, scarf or gaiter, waterproof jacket and pants, and goggles (optional, but HIGHLY recommended if possible).
- ❖ **School Book Bag** – students may do homework on bus to and from ski resort.

SO GET OFF THAT COUCH, AND GET OUT ON THE SLOPES AND HAVE SOME FUN! SNOW IS RIGHT AROUND THE CORNER!
